

Keep People & Country Safe When Doing Weed Works

Always ask—How can I do weed work smarter, better and safer?

Use methods such as burning, handpulling, seeding, slashing and grazing as alternatives to herbicide wherever possible.

Support healthy ecosystems to buffer the impacts of weeds and minimise the use of herbicide.

Minimize amounts required by altering practices: ie. remove bulk of biomass first and reduce the weed in size and strength.

Use the lowest schedule chemicals possible to minimize human and environmental impact. Be fully aware of human and environmental safety and important information, MSDS, Labels etc.

No-one HAS to use herbicides- it is a matter of making an informed choice.

Herbicides should be applied in a discrete fashion, ie. Killing the target and avoiding other species.

*The use of herbicides in weed areas should continue to decline over time.
Chemically addicted landscapes are NOT the way forward.*
